1. Introduction

AccountingWise attaches great importance to the protection of personal data and processes such data in accordance with applicable laws and regulations, including the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

This privacy policy explains which personal data are processed, for what purposes, on what legal basis, and what rights data subjects have.

4. Personal data we process

Depending on the nature of the relationship, we may process the following personal data:

- First and last name
- Address details
- Telephone number
- E-mailadres
- Job or function details
- Bank account number
- Data regarding website usage
- Gender (if relevant to the services provided).

5. Purposes and legal basis

We process personal data for the following purposes and on the corresponding legal bases:

- Execution of assignments (performance of a contract)
- Financial Administration (legal obligation)
- Payroll administration (legal obligation / contract)
- Website analysis (legitimate interest)

- Marketing (consent or legitimate interest)

6. Automated decision-making

AccountingWise does not make decisions based on automated processing that could have significant consequences for individuals.

7. Retention periods

Personal data are not retained longer than necessary for the purposes for which they were collected, unless a statutory retention period applies.

- Financial Administration: 7 years (legal obligation)
- Other data: as long as necessary for the provision of services

After the retention period, data will be deleted or anonymised.

8. Sharing of personal data with third parties

AccountingWise only shares personal data with third parties where necessary, such as:

- Accounting software providers
- Payroll processors
- IT and hosting providers
- E-mail service providers

9. Cookies

AccountingWise uses cookies. We use functional and analytical cookies. Where applicable, marketing cookies may also be used, for which prior consent will be requested. You can disable cookies via your browser settings.

10. Rights of data subjects

You have the following rights:

- Right of access
- Right to rectification
- Right to erasure
- Right to restriction of processing
- Right to data portability
- Right to object
- Right to withdraw consent

Requests can be submitted to the contact person for privacy.

11. Identification

To prevent misuse, identification may be requested. You are advised to mask sensitive information (such as your social security number and photograph) when providing identification.

12. Complaints

If you believe that the processing of personal data violates applicable law, you may:

- Contact AccountingWise
- Lodge a complaint with the Dutch Data Protection Authority (Autoriteit Persoonsgegevens)

13. Security

AccountingWise takes appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect personal data, including:

- Secure connections (SSL)
- Access restrictions
- Password protection
